



VaYeitzei-He Went Out: A Love Story!!

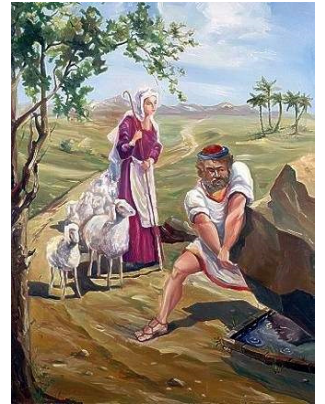
This is YOUR Year! Seek Truth & to Be Transformed OK??

Gen 28.10-32:3; Hosea 11:7-14:10; John 1:43-51 (#7)

This study shows us life in Yeshua, the Mayim Chaim. It also shows the deceit and the control of the worldly items in our hearts. The fear of man and of the world systems causes us to do some foolish things as we see Jacob/Yakov doing. Yahweh made a mighty covenant with him, the same one He made with his fathers. This is the same covenant he made with you today, because of the covenant through the seed of Abraham, Yeshua. I pray we walk in His obedience, which brings authority in your life. Let these examples in Torah encourage you to know Him in a way you have never known before.

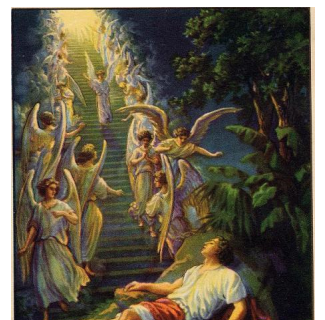
Hosea 11:7-14:9; In Haftarah VaYeitzei

Yahweh speaks of the problems that He has with both Houses of Israel. The House of Ephraim/Israel has been unfaithful and will be judged by Assyria and spread out by the wind. The House of Judah at the time was remaining faithful to the Torah and the covenant of Yahweh, but had a rebellious heart and will be judged later according to his “doings.” Ephraim was taken into Assyrian captivity in 722-721 B.C.E. and was never corporately heard from again. Judah was taken into Babylonian exile approximately two hundred years later. Judah was more faithful to the Torah and to the covenant than Ephraim was, but both Houses of Israel were rebellious. As our Heavenly Father reunites all of Israel in our day, we must redouble our efforts to commit ourselves to His Word and His ways.



A Few Hebrew Definitions

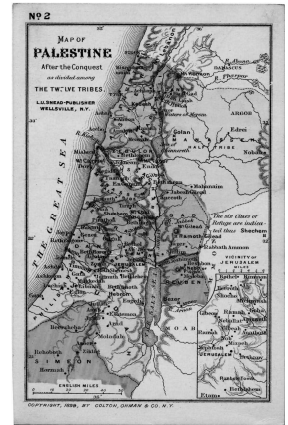
1. **Beer-Sheba, H884** בַּר שֶׁבַע **Beer-sheba:** “Well of the sevenfold oath or promise.”
2. **Stone, H68,** אֶבֶן **'eben:** stone, precious stones, stones of fire, sacred object. Memorial Samuel marked where God defeated the Philistines (Exod 25:7), means a precious Jewelry setting. Symbolic of the word “tsur,” = Rock—a term for the Messiah. (Isaiah 28:16) A Precious stone set in Tzion.
3. **Ladder/Staircase, H5551** סֻלָּם **sullam:** ladder, stairway. John 1:51, Yeshua is that ladder between the heavenly realms and the earthly on which all travel.
4. **Ascending, H5927** עָלָה **'alah:** to go up, ascend, climb.
5. **Descending, H3381** יָרַד **yarad:** go down, descend, to be prostrated.
6. **Burnt Offering H5930** עֹלָה **'olah:** as going up in smoke, to go up, ascent, stairway, steps.
7. **Bethel, H1008** בֵּית־אֵל **beyth'el:** (Beit-El) “house of God.”



Notes that point to Yeshua (
Transformed people can Find HIM)



- A. **Jacob's Ladder:** Jacob travels and stops to rest, he puts his head on a Rock, Stone, (Yeshua- **Isaiah 28:16**), and in his sleep (in Yeshua), he sees the ladder on which heavenly beings are ascending and descending from Heaven to Earth. All life must go through the ladder to enter into the heavenly realms. Yeshua is the bridge to the spiritual realms of the Kingdom of the Father, YHVH. **Gen. 28:12**—The staircase was a visible symbol of the real and uninterrupted fellowship between God in heaven and His people upon earth. Elohim is used here, “Angels of Elohim-God” (H430)
- John 1:51** “Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man, Yeshua.”
 - John 10:9** “I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved & shall go in and out, and find pasture.”
 - The Angels are here for the purpose of ministering to the Heirs—US!! **Heb 1:14** “Are they (Angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?”
- B. **In verse 13**, we see the Father, (YHVH is used here in Hebrew), above the ladder, giving His covenant to Jacob—the same covenant He gave to his fathers. This is the same covenant given unto you as the sons of adoption, grafted in to Israel through the seed, Yeshua. **Gen 17:2, Gen 22:16-18, Gal 3: 16**
- Gen 28:13-15** “... I am the LORD God who was worshiped by Abraham and Isaac. I will give to you and your family the land on which you are now sleeping. Your descendants will spread over the earth in all directions and will become as numerous as the specks of dust. Your family will be a blessing to all people. Wherever you go, I will watch over you, then later I will bring you back to this land. I won't leave you--I will do all I have promised.”
- C. **Chapter 29**
- V.1-3:** Jacob comes to the land of his mother, (the land of the remnant). The well is where there is life, the living waters. Notice there are 3 flocks waiting for the giver of living water. Who is waiting at the well for the kingdom to be given, who are the 3 flocks??
 - V.9-14:** When Rachel (the picture of us/the Bride) comes to the well she sees Jacob (the promise of the Birthright, for the future bride). He makes it possible for the well to be opened, and Rachel has the living water. This is also the lineage that produced the Anointed One, Messiah. The well is a picture of the life in Yeshua, opened to give Life from the Mayim, in the well. Just as we saw last week, the wells that Abraham dug and the world filled over and Isaac redug to give life to His people, we see the analogy again as a picture of Yeshua in the well (us). Giving life in every word we speak, every word of love, every encouragement; every act we make gives life or death. Be free! The Living Water is right there and Jesus/Yeshua paid the price for us to be in HIM, the Living Water, the Mayim Chaim. Don't let the world cover up HIS life in You. Give it all up for HIM.
 - V.10-11:** Jacob sees his Bride among the other sheep. He rolled the stone away, and then he wept and kissed the bride. The Bride has been found—all heaven rejoices!
 - V.14-30;** Jacob works for the bride: a picture of Yeshua battling for the bride. Doing only the will of the Father.
 - John 5:30** “I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father, which hath sent me.” (**Deut 21:10**)
- D. **29:31–30:24** Jacob has ten sons and one daughter before God anoints the barren womb of Rachel. Her first-born Joseph is born, and then she prays for another son.
- E. **Jacob lived in the house of Laban** as a servant to men. **1Co 7:23** “Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.”
- We see how hard it is for Jacob to leave the house of the World, Egypt/Babylon. These old ways have been engrained in our mind and soul, (We mourn for Tammuz-**Ezek 8**).
- F. **Jacob takes all the spotted and striped livestock.** Is this a picture of Yeshua finding all the imperfect sheep? He is the only Righteous and perfect one. Our righteousness is as filthy rags. (**Isa 64:6** “But we are all as an unclean [thing], and all our righteousness [are] as filthy rags.”)
- G. **Chapter 31** Yeshua tells Jacob to leave and go back to the “Land.” But just like us, Rachel holds on to her father's worldly idols, like us wanting more of the world.
- V.22** Laban pursues, just like Egypt pursued Moses. The world is not happy with you being dependent on Yahweh instead of them. They will always persecute and try to bring you back in to their ways and religious beliefs. Have you seen this in your own life, from friends, family and ex-pastors?? Trying to keep you in bondage to the ‘undernourished flock,’ doctrines and traditions of men and to worldly ways? Walk in Righteousness as He causes you to (**Ezek 36**).
- H. **Genesis 32:1-3** Jacob, proceeding on his Journey, is met by the angels of God, and sends messengers before him to his brother Esau.



A Study in Wells (H875) Be'er בְּאֵר be-ayr'

☞ Three famous wells

- Beer-elim**, H879 בְּאֵר אֵלִים be-ayr' ay-leem' well of heroes.
Isaiah 15:8 From H875
- Beer-lahai-roi**. H883 בְּאֵר לַחַי רֹאִי be-ayr' lakh-ah'ee ro-ee': well of a living (One) my Seer; From H875
- Beer Sheba**, H884 בְּאֵר שֶׁבַע be-ayr' sheh'-bah: well of an oath, seven-fold oath, 34 times. From H875



- ☞ **Well** = from the Root Word, **H874 ba'ar**. A verb: “to make plain, distinct, to make clear, to declare, letters on a tablet.” Letters on a tablet, of flesh, your heart. The well is the living water, where the covenant is written on your heart. **Heb 8:10** “and write them in their hearts.” **Ezek 36**, flesh tablets.

- ☞ The wells were a place for the source of life, a meeting place, a place to think, a place to make a covenant, a valuable asset, even unto war. All Israel is a desert; only the river valleys are green because of the waters from the rivers. So a well is life, Living Waters, Kadosh, Mayim Chaim—Yeshua!!!
- ☞ Sarah (tradition tells us), Rebecca in **Gen 24:15**, and Rachel in **Gen 29:6**; all came to the wells of Yeshua, living waters.
- ☞ **Be'er (H875) is in all these scriptures; 37 times as Well, wells, & pits:**
 - **Genesis 14:10** slime pits ⁽⁸⁷⁵⁾ to the evil kings of Sodom & Gomorrah.
 - **Genesis 16:14** Beer-lahai-roi; well of the living one.
 - **Genesis 21:19** Life to Hagar
 - **Genesis 21:25** Don't take my wells of life, Abraham to Abimelech
 - **Genesis 21:30** For covenant
 - **Genesis 24:11** Life for all
 - **Genesis 24:20** Rebecca gives life to Eliezer
 - **Genesis 26:25** Where you worship, where you live, seek HIM, dig a well.
 - **Genesis 26:32** When you seek, you will find Life – Yeshua
 - **Genesis 29:2** Don't let anyone cover the well
 - **Genesis 29:3** Protect your well
 - **Genesis 29:8** The living water is for one and all
 - **Genesis 29:10** Help others to the Water
 - **Exodus 2:15** A place for solace, meditation and prayer.
 - **Numbers 20:17** Don't seek the waters from other sources.
 - **Numbers 21:16** Be'er, life in the wilderness/desert.
 - **Numbers 21:17** "Spring up, O well", Earliest song of Life.
 - **Numbers 21:18** The giver of the law, Moses shows us where the water is located, Yeshua.
 - **Genesis 26:15** The world covers over the wells of life, with substitutions
 - **Genesis 26:18** Isaac renews life in Abraham's wells.
 - **Genesis 26:19** Isaac's servants find new Mayim Chaim of springing water.
 - **Genesis 26:20** Always need to defend your Mayim
 - **Genesis 26:21** When you seek, you will find Life – Yeshua
 - **Genesis 26:22** Now seek with all you heart, might, strength, and soul (Flesh).
 - **Numbers 21:22** We don't want the water of the world.
 - **2 Samuel 17:18** This man had life in his home.
 - **2 Samuel 17:19** This well was also the life of the bread, Lechem.
 - **2 Samuel 17:21** The priest's son and the King's son hid in the well, Our life is hide in HIM.
 - **Psalms 55:23** Those not in Him will be the well, (pit) of destruction
 - **Psalms 69:15** Let us not be swallowed in the pit (well) of destruction.
 - **Proverbs 5:15** Drink from HIS Well, Life.
 - **Proverbs 23:27** The pleasures will devour you into it's pit.
 - **Song of Solomon 4:15** The fountain in the gardens is the well of living waters. **John 7:37-38**
- ☞ **Wells in the NT, Brit Hadashah (G4077) πηγή pēgē pay-gay'**
 - This Greek word is defined as the idea of gushing plumply; a fount (literally or figuratively), that is, source or supply (of water, blood, enjoyment), fountain, well.
 - **Mar 5:29; John 4:6; John 4:14; Jam 3:11; Jam 3:12; 2Pe 2:17; Rev 7:17; Rev 8:10; Rev 14:7; Rev 16:4; Rev 21:6;**
 - **John 7:38** "He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers ^{G4215*} of living water."
 - *G4215 ποταμός potamos pot-am-o: a current, brook or freshet (as drinkable), that is, running water: (Kodosh), flood, river, stream, water.

1. **Tell me what Yahweh said to Yaakov/Jacob in His Dream. It is awesome, and it has been said before, and is being said by Yahweh today—what is that promise??**
2. **Where was Jacob headed when he left Beersheba?? What were two reasons for him to leave??**
3. **Where did Jacob spend the night and how would you interpret his dream??**
4. **Why did Jacob set up a sacred pillar (mazzevah) at Bethel, and anoint it with oil?**
5. **What did Jacob say about this place that night??** *He had “fear” (28:17), which was what Yahweh needed to know regarding Abraham at the Akeidah (Gen 22:12), so Yahweh could make the ‘Covenant’ with him. Gen 28:16-17 “The LORD is in this place, and I didn't even know it.’ Then Jacob feared Yahweh and said, ‘This is a fearsome place! It must be the house of God and the ladder to heaven.’”*
6. **Did Jacob make a vow at this time?**
7. **What do you think the Stone over the Well was symbolic of??**
8. **What do you think the 3 flocks of sheep mean and why were they waiting??**
9. **Why did Jacob weep and kiss Rachel when he met her??** (Remember this is the Bride)
10. **What do you think it means ‘Leah had tender eyes’??**
11. **From Leah’s point of view, was Jacob honorable?? And do you think Laban’s deception had anything to do with Jacob’s deception over his brother?**
