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# ra-And He Called: & He Called You

#### (#24) Lev 1:1-5:26(6:7); Isaiah 43:21-44:23; 1 Sam 15:1-34;Rom 8:1-13; Hebrews 10:1-18; 13:10-16

**Torah Overview:** This week's study is a powerful picture of Yeshua. The five types of Korban (offerings) listed below are to bring us into HIS presence. We will always have a struggle with the flesh, even as Shaul (Paul) wrote in Romans 5; we continue to "do what we don't want to do, and we don't do what we should do." Why? *Our flesh is still alive and it is warring* Leviticu with our Yeshua Spirit in us. Thank Yahweh we have HIS Love, passion and the Korban of HIS flesh life, Yeshua.

ויקרא An offering implies a gift, which satisfies the receiver. Just "COME NEAR!" The Almighty does not need our gifts—He has no needs or desires. The Hebrew word is korban, which is best translated as a means of bringing oneself into a closer relationship with the Almighty. The offerings or korbanot were only for our benefit to come close to the Almighty. All of these are Yeshua. Now we can bring them as Holy before the Lord as I Peter 2:5 tells us to bring these holy & acceptable offerings to HIM. HafTorah Overview: —What a great picture of the "elect" or the "anointed one." It is a picture of us; we are appointed to destroy the enemy, but we have kept King Agag alive and with all the spoils, some openly and some kept in secret.

### A Few Hebrew Definitions

- Offering, (Lev 1-5) H7133 און קרב און <u>Korban:</u> (qorban or korban): offering, oblation. From the Root word to Come close, draw near.
- Burnt, H5930 עלה Olah: elevate, whole burnt offering, to ascend, stairway, steps.
- Meal Offering, H4503 מנחה Minchah: gift, tribute, offering, grain, The Word Yeshua!
- Peace Offering, H8002 ש כלם Shalom: peace, offering for alliance, friendship.
- Sin offering, H2403 השאה Chatah: sin offering, purification from uncleanness, miss the
- Trespass offering, H817 מש Asham: guilt, offense, guiltiness, trespass, payment for 6.

### Notes that point to





#### Yeshua

All through this teaching of offering, we have a mighty physical and spiritual accounting of the Lamb—it's all Yeshua. Where Does Yeshua live and where is His temple? All these are for the Body today. Elevate, Fellowship and give peace to the Body of Messiah; this is your spiritual offerings and your calling. Of the 5 Offering we have in Lev 1-5, are any of them still for today?

- A. Lev #1: The Ascension/elevation offering, burnt offering. Voluntary (see chart to see the fulfillment in Yeshua)
  - Olah is to elevate, give of yourself and lift up one another. 1Co 14:3 But someone prophesying is speaking to people, edifying, encouraging and comforting them. Encourage & comfort (Eph 6:22; 2 Cor 2:7; Col 4:8, I Thes 3:2, II Thess 2:17)
  - In Lev 1:1, Yahweh called Moses to talk, Look at this; He called & chose you., He appointed you to do His Works, John 15:16.
  - There was a daily burnt offering, a lamb of the first year, every morning & evening (Ex 29:38-42). Sabbath was double; the offering at the new moon; the three great feasts—Passover, Pentecost, and Tabernacles; also on the great Day of Atonement and the Feast of Trumpets.
  - Did the sacrifices end with Yeshua? The religious performances? 4.
    - **Psa 51:17** "The offerings of God are a broken spirit; a broken & sorrowing heart, O God, you will not despise." (Please See Ezek 9:4)
    - 1Ki 3:15 "Solomon awoke; &, behold, [it was] a dream. He came to Jerusalem, & stood before the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and peace offerings, and made a feast to all his servants."
    - iii. Rom 12:1 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service."
    - **Hos 6:6** "For I desired mercy, & not sacrifice; the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings."



- v. **1 Sa 15:22** "Tell me,' Samuel said. 'Does the LORD really want sacrifices and offerings? No! He doesn't want your sacrifices. He wants you to obey him."
- vi. **Isa 1:11-13** "Your sacrifices mean nothing to me. **I am sick of your offerings** of rams and choice cattle; I don't like the blood of bulls or lambs or goats. Who asked you to bring all this when you come to worship me? Stay out of my temple! Your sacrifices are worthless, and incense is disgusting. I can't stand the evil you do on your New Moon Festivals or on your Sabbaths and other times of worship."
- vii. Micah 6:6-8 "Wherewith shall I come before the LORD, bow myself before the high God? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves of a year old? Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, [or] with ten thousands of rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? He hath shown thee, O man, what is good; and what the LORD requires of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God." Please see Matt 23:23
- 5. **Mat 23:23** "Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye pay tithe of mint, anise & cumin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the Torah, justice, mercy, and faithfulness..."
- 6. Mat 9:13 "But go and learn what that means, I will have mercy, not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."
- B. Lev #2: Fellowship-Meal/grain Offering, grain with salt (see chart for comparisons)
- 1. Minchah is a picture of you Giving Life, a fellowship offering of the Living Word. This is your Spiritual offering, 1Pet 2:5
- 2. Mark 9:49-50 "For every one shall be salted with fire, and every sacrifice shall be salted with salt. Salt [is] good: but if the salt has lost its saltiness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace one with another."
- 3. Mat 5:13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if its taste goes from the salt, how will you make it salt again? It is then good for nothing but to be put out and crushed under foot by men."
- 4. Col 4:6 "Let your talk be with grace, mixed with salt, so that you may be able to give an answer to everyone."
- 5. Fulfilled in Messiah; **John 6:51** "I am the living bread which has come from heaven: if any man takes this bread for food he will have life for ever: and more than this, the bread which I will give is my flesh which I will give for the life of the world."
- 6. **John 12:24** "Truly I say to you, if a seed of grain does not go into the earth and come to an end, it is still a seed and no more; but through its death it gives much fruit."
- C. Lev #3: Peace Offering—Shalom. For reconciliation of your life. The Covering of God, Fear Him and nothing else, and you will have peace. This is through Messiah. 1 Pet 2:5 Give peace it is your Spiritual Offering.
  - 1. Ps 111:10, Prov 1:9 "The Fear of the Lord is the beginning of Wisdom and Knowledge." No Peace w/o it!!
  - 2. Rom 5:1 "We have righteousness through faith, let us be at peace with God through our Lord Yeshua;"
  - 3. Col 1:20 "And God was pleased for him to make peace by sacrificing his blood on the cross, so that all beings in heaven and on earth would be brought back to God."
  - 4. You have a covenant of Peace. John 14:27 "Peace I leave with you My peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- D. Lev #4: Sin Offerings. See Chart for examples. Sin (Chata) and Trespass (Asham) are different but will lead to Death or realms of unclean. Sin offering is for unintentional sin. (see F)
  - 1. **1 Co 15:56** "The sting of death is sin, and the meaning of sin is in the Torah;"
  - 2. Hos 14:2 "Return to the LORD and say, 'Please forgive our sins. Accept our good sacrifices of praise instead of bulls."
  - 3. Rom8:2 "For the Torah of the Spirit of life, in Messiah Yeshua, has made me free from the law of sin/death."
  - 4. Our Sin is Forgiven In Yeshua. Even in the Torah Yeshua was the redemption for the realms of Trespass and Sin; The Water of Purification. **Numbers 19:1-10**—The Red Heifer.
  - 5. **2 Co 5:21** "He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."
  - 6. **Heb 10:9-17** "then He said, 'BEHOLD, I HAVE COME TO DO YOUR WILL.' He takes away the first in order to establish the second. By this will we have all been sanctified through the offering of the body of Yeshua the Messiah once for all. And every priest stands daily serving and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins; but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins perpetually, SAT DOWN AT THE RIGHT HAND of God, waiting from that time onward UNTIL HIS ENEMIES BE MADE A FOOTSTOOL FOR HIS FEET. For by one offering He has brought to the goal perpetually for all time those who are sanctified. And the Holy Spirit also bears witness to us; for after saying, THIS IS THE COVENANT THAT I WILL MAKE WITH THEM AFTER THOSE DAYS,' SAYS ADONAI: 'I WILL PUT MY TORAHS UPON THEIR HEARTS, AND UPON THEIR MINDS I WILL INSCRIBE THEM, AND THEIR SIN AND LAWLESSNESS I WILL REMEMBER NO MORE.'"
- E. Lev #5: Trespass-Asham, realms of unclean, which leads to death.
  - 1. Col 2:13 "And you, being dead through your trespasses and the un-circumcision of your flesh, you, I say, did he make alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses;"
  - 2. **2Co 5:19** "...that is, that God was in Messiah reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and has put the word of reconciliation in us." (Cheshbon Nephesh)
- F. Where is the Sacrifice/Korban for <u>Intentional Sins of Disobedience?</u> Heb 10:26-31; Jer 31:34b; Heb 10:17, Ps 25:7

Please note Yeshua is all 5 of these offering. He was elevated, He is the Living Word, He is our peace, our offering for sin and trespass. He lives in you so give of the 1st three voluntary offerings, it is your spiritual duty, the living sacrifice. Love ya

<u>Tune in next week:</u> If we are called to be a nation of Priests, Holy and Separate UNTO Yahweh for HIS service, then why haven't we ever been consecrated as HIS Priests?

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## Vayikra-And He Called Q A for YOU and Some that needs to get on Fire!

Lev 1:1-5:26; I Sam 15:2-34; Isaiah 43:21-44:23;

Here are a few questions designed to get you and your family into the Word, the Living Word of Yeshua. He is the same yesterday and today. Let his daily manna provoke you to Love and the love of Yeshua will reign in your life. We are called to be overcomers and that doesn't happen by accident. Get into his Fire. Be Blessed In His name.

- Leviticus Aleph (One)—Burnt Offering
- Leviticus Gimmel (Three)—Peace Offering
- ◆ Leviticus Beit (Two)—Meal Offering
- Leviticus Dalet (Four)—Sin Offering
- Leviticus Hey (Five)—Trespass Offering
- 1. **In Chapter One, what was the purpose of the action in verse 4?** I believe it was transferring something from the person to the animal. In some cases the transfer of sin, and in others the gift of offering oneself to the Lord. The Laying on of Hands is the transferring of the Spirit Realms of Life or Death. Yeshua took upon Himself ALL of our Sins and Transgressions. He is our Atonement, our covering, our Redemption through His obedience to the sacrifices in Torah.
- 2. Who do you think did the actual killing of the sacrifice? (See verse 5) The person bringing the animal. We are those people and we have to dig deep and do the sacrifice of Reconciliation—of Overcoming to the End.
- 3. **Of the Five offerings in this portion which are voluntary?** The burnt offering, the meal offering and the peace offering.
- 4. Of the Five offerings in this portion which are compulsory? The sin offering and trespass offering.
- 5. In Lev 1 we have the Burnt offering. What is the Hebrew word, and what does this word really mean? <u>Olah</u>: To Ascend or to go up in smoke—like when your prayers and your life ascend to the bowl of the Prayers of the Saints (Rev 5:8, Rev 8:3-4).
- 6. **How do you think Romans 12:1 applies to the Burnt offering?** Our prayers going up to Him. As we give our whole selves to Him daily, it is a sweet fragrance to Him. Our lives are to be the sweet incense unto Him.
- 7. What was the purpose of the Burnt offering in Lev 1 and the Meal offering in Lev 2?
  - a. The Burnt offering is to be a gift of a sweet fragrance to the Lord, a gift of love, and to be an atonement for the one bringing it. It is voluntary to bring us into His Presence more often. It is also a sweet savor and for feeding the priests. It was also a consecration of one's self unto Yahweh.
  - b. The Meal offering or grain was a consecration of our lives and our possessions as unto Yahweh. It is a picture of the Bread of Life, Yeshua. We need to keep our lives, our bread sanctified and holy before HIM.
- 8. What is the Hebrew word for meal offering? Minchah Offering, The Bread of Life Yeshua.
- 9. **Read Gal 6:2 and Rev 8:3-4 and tell me what you think the purpose of the Burnt offering is.** To be the prayers of the saints. Possibly the bearing of one another's burdens in that we send prayers to God for others (intercession). Actually the smoke ascended (Olah) up with the prayers of the saints in Revelation.
- 10. **Read John 12:24 and John 6:51, and in relation to the Meal offering, try to explain the purpose**. Yeshua represents the bread of life. He is what we are to consume. The meal offering was an offering of unleavened bread and oil. That unleavened bread is Yeshua. He died and rose again, but only His flesh died. The grain of corn that goes into the ground dies off, but first produces new life in the new stalk of corn. **John 12:24** is also a great picture of US, sacrificing ourselves, our lives, to Yeshua—being willing to die in our flesh so that we might LIVE IN HIM by the Spirit.
- 11. In Lev 3 we have a Shalom (fellowship) offering—what do you think this was for? It was an offering given in thanks. A thank you gift to Yahweh. It is an offering of thankfulness, voluntarily given from the heart—a heart that desires to be in fellowship with Yahweh and with all of His Body. It is also an offering to make peace with our God and with His family. His Shalom is the absence of confusion, it is His peace in our lives, and you have it, so give it!!
- 12. If you read Col 1:20; Rom 5:1; Eph 2:15; Col 3:15 and John 14:27, you will see a powerful picture of Peace and the fulfillment of this in Messiah. How does this offering apply to your life today? When we offer praises to the Lord and also prayers of thanks to Him. When we have Messiah in our life He gives us peace and we give thanks to Him for the peace He gives us. Yeshua has made the peace offering to God on our behalf so that we can have peace with Him. As we rest in the work that He did for us, we have peace and can truly be thankful to God that the work has been accomplished for us. This is a picture of the growth in our FAITH.
- 13. When we teach the realms of "Unclean" we are teaching tamei, which is the result of a trespass. We have been taught everything is sin, but can you tell me what this offering is for and how does it apply to us today? It is obvious that there are different categories of trespass. The offering is the same for all. Unintentional sin, touching unclean and many other areas of trespass are all remedied or covered in the same way. There is no covering for intentional sin. The sinner bears the consequences of his sin, reaping what he has sown. However, not everything is sin. Sometimes we hear something unintentionally, but are still defiled by it and need to confess it to God and be cleansed. We may eat something we didn't know was unclean, and so need to confess and be cleansed. These areas are clearly trespass, however they are not intentional from a heart of rebellion. That is the difference between trespass and intentional sin.
- 14. Get the whole family together and put together a chart to compare all five of these offerings and see if it gives you a better picture of these offerings, (sacrifices) and if you see a clearer picture of Yeshua's Sacrifice!! You can see above I have put a chart together for you, so take a moment and compare the offerings and you'll see all of them are a Picture of Messiah, Yeshua, and Us—his Bride who has been redeemed.
- 15. In 1 Peter 2:5, 9 it says we are still to make Spiritual Sacrifices. Can you explain how to give Lev 1, 2, 3: an elevation, a fellowship and a peace offering?

May Yahweh bless you and keep you. It helps if you seek Him, (especially if you use some of your heart, soul, strength and might.)
